Historical- Eclecticism mainly drew its influences from other historical art genres. It began as a way to classify works that used different components of the Renaissance Era and Classical Era together in one work.

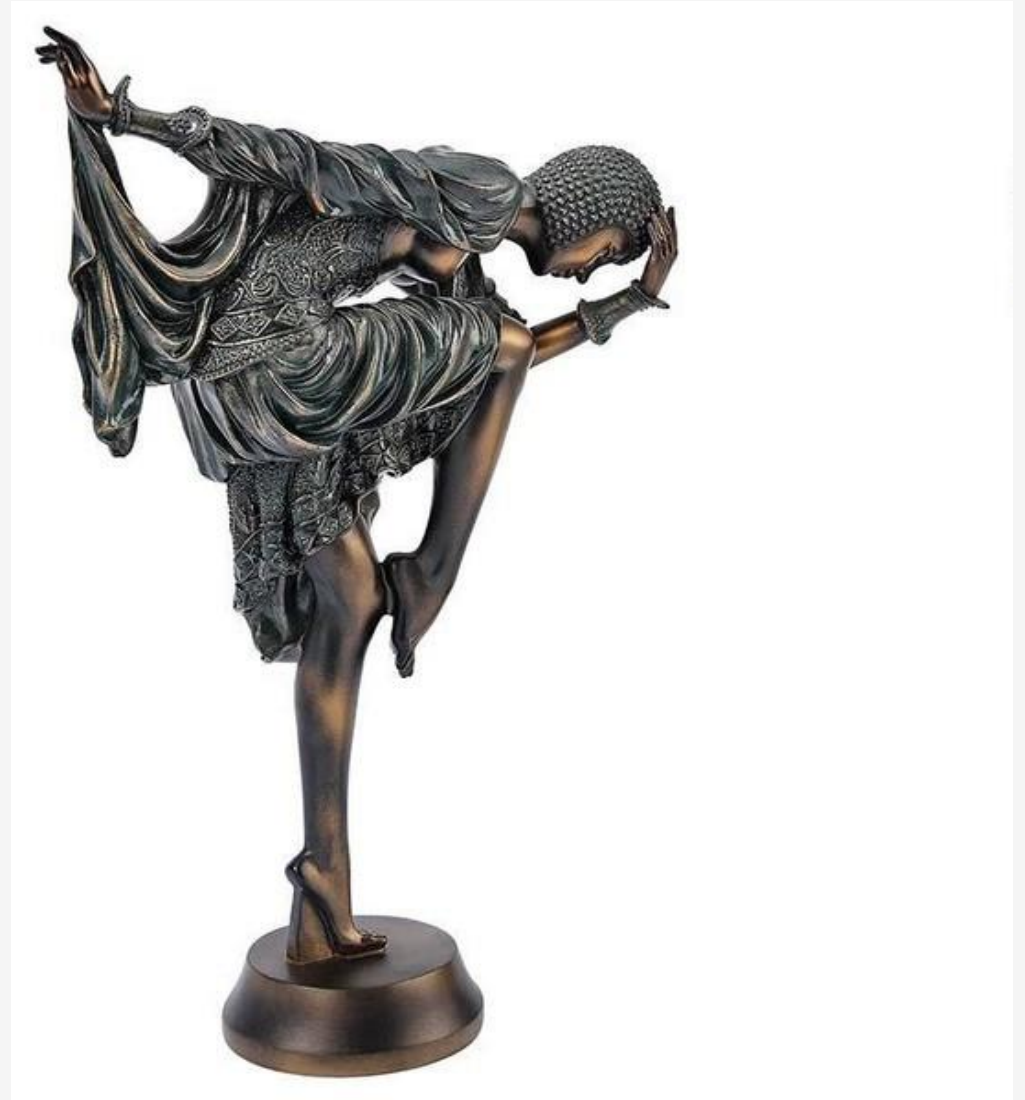
